

# WEEKLY UPDATE

Your hands will show in some poses, so clean & presentable nails and your favourite ring will enhance your portraits.

#### ONCE THE PHOTO SESSION IS COMPLETE:

A few weeks after your portrait session your school will distribute secure login information and link to the Pegasus proofing website. #### SAFE ARRIVAL

Please remember to report your child's absence using the <a href="SAFEARRIVAL">SAFEARRIVAL</a> portal. With the office being a very busy place, you can also put in an **EARLY DEPARTURE**. This will allow us to have your child ready and at the office for the time you have selected. Often when parents call at the last minute, it may be difficult to
