

Kindergarten Registration

Children turning 4 years old by December 31st, 2025

In order to finalize your child's registration, you will need the following (original) documentation:

- Proof of child's Legal Name (Birth Certificate, Birth Registration Form)
- Proof of your child's age (Birth Certificate, Birth Registration Form, Baptismal Certificate, Passport)
- Proof of full address (e.g. bank statement, utility bill, or similar documentation). In rural areas please include your RR, lot and concession numbers
 - Your child's citizenship or landed immigrant papers
 Any relevant custody order documents

Instructions for Creating an Online Registration Account

Enable Pop-Ups: Before you begin, please ensure that pop-ups are enabled in your browser settings. This is necessary for the registration process to work smoothly.

Create Account:

Go to the Online Registration page

Click on the Create Account button

Enter Your Details:

First Name: Enter your first name. Last Name: Enter your last name.

Email Address: Provide a valid email address.

Password: Create a secure password for your account.

Confirmation Message

After entering your details, a message will pop up on the screen indicating that an email has been sent to activate your account.

Activate Your Account:

Check your email inbox for the activation email

Follow the instructions in the email to activate your account.

The Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee (NCPIC) supports the Mission of Catholic education and the Mission, Vision and Values of the Niagara Catholic District School Board by providing a communication link to parents/guardians, Catholic School Councils, the Diocese, the Director of Education, and the Board. The NCPIC promotes active parent/guardian engagement within all schools for the improvement of student achievement and well-being of all students in the Niagara Catholic District School Board.

The NCPIC membership is made up of parents/guardians, community and student representatives, the Bishop of the Diocese of St. Catharines or his appointed representative, principals, teachers, support staff, the Director of Education or designate, the appointed Superintendent of Education and Trustees. The Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee meets on the first Thursday of the month, on a bi-monthly basis (or as noted) at the Catholic Education Centre from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Meetings are open to the public, livestreamed and recorded.

COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES

- must reside within the jurisdiction of the Board;
- must support the Mission, Vision and Values of the Niagara Catholic District School Board; and
- must fully participate in the annual Commissioning Ceremony of NCPIC members.
