Junior Girls Handball


Congratulations to the Junior Girls Handball team for taking 1st place in their division and winning the finals in a thrilling overtime battle!


The girls represented SJHN with pride! We are incredibly proud of their hard work, determination, and outstanding sportsmanship throughout the tournament.
