Class Organization for 2025-2026

Please trust our professional judgment to make good pedagogically sound decisions regarding your child's class placement for September 2025. Talk positively and hopefully to your child about next year. If your child is with a different group of students, discuss the value of new friendships and fresh starts. We are looking forward to another wonderful school year with your support. Please know that careful thought is always given to student placement in the various classes. Guidelines that we consider may be one, some or all of the following:

Learning style/social needs

- **Work habits**
- Special program needs
- Behavior

In all class situations, present and receiving teachers meet with the Principal and Education Resource Teacher to make the final decision. Parent preference cannot be a determining factor, but if you have a pressing concern regarding class placement, please put your request and reasons in writing to the attention of Mr. Spagnol and hand it into the office for consideration by Friday, May 30th, 2025.

Due to the amount of students that need to be placed, any requests after <u>May 30th</u> will not be considered.
