



New Pope - New Hope

HABEMUS PAPAM!

May 8 was an exciting day for Catholics around the world as we saw the white smoke emerge from the chimney atop the Sistine Chapel. Shortly after, our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV emerged



on the balcony offering an expression of peace along with his first papal blessing. At the school, we had the event live streamed on our foyer TV, and some staff and students saw parts of the live event!

Who is Pope Leo XIV?

Born on September 14, 1955, in Chicago, Illinois, Robert Francis Prevost was the third son to Louis Prevost and Mildred Martínez. Even at a young age his love for Jesus and the Church was evident. When his older brothers were outside playing with their bikes, or building forts, he was pretending to be a priest celebrating Mass for his family with an ironing board for an altar. After completing grade 8 he entered the Minor Seminary of the Augustinian Fathers and then continued his studies at Villanova University where he obtained a degree in mathematics and studied philosophy. In 1977, he entered the Order of Saint Augustine and made his solemn vows in 1981. He later was sent to Rome to study Canon Law at the Angelicum and was ordained a priest in 1982. He spent many years as a missionary priest, teacher, and bishop in Peru before Pope Francis called him to serve in Rome. In 2023, he was made Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and the President of the Pontifical Commission for Latin America. He was created a cardinal by Pope Francis in 2024. As a Catholic community, we keep our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, in our prayers as he begins his Petrine ministry. May God bless him with courage, wisdom, and good health as he takes on this new role as the successor of Saint Peter.

Lunch Delivery

If you are dropping off a lunch or having one delivered to the school, please have your child's first and last name clearly labeled on the package. Please make sure delivery services have the student's name when dropping off lunches. Also, please verify in your SchoolCashOnline portal that you ordered lunches on our Specialty Food Days. We do not order extras and will not have additional food in case your child doesn't have a lunch. We do always have additional items in our snack bins and we will do our



best to provide food if they cannot contact you. Please review the new student Nutrition Break times.

SAFE ARRIVAL



Please remember to report your child's absence using the SAFEARRIVAL portal. With the office being a very busy place, you can also put in an EARLY DEPARTURE. This will allow us to have your child ready and at the office for the time you have selected. Often when parents call at the last minute, it may be difficult to

get students down at the office due to the large number of calls. Advanced planning will be extremely helpful.
