Mass begins at 2:00pm but all students are asked to be ready and in their pews by 1:45 pm.

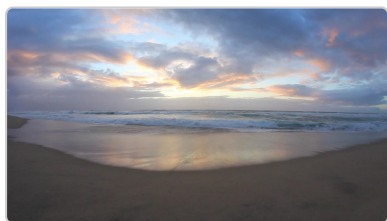

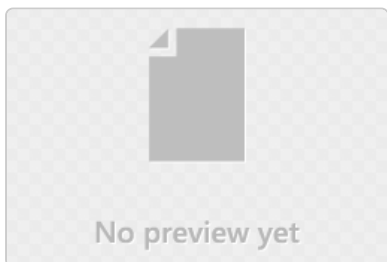
