

Balanced Day 2025-26

As we continue to work together as a Catholic community of learners, this letter is to notify you that all Niagara Catholic elementary schools will continue to be on a Balanced School Day schedule. A Balanced School Day is a modified elementary school schedule designed to enhance learning, foster healthy habits, and encourage daily physical activity.

This schedule comprises three instructional blocks interspersed with two nutritional breaks of approximately 40 minutes, allowing 20 minutes for a nourishing lunch and an additional 20 minutes for indoor and/or outdoor physical activity.

A typical Monday to Friday Balanced School Day at St. Peter would be:

8:30-10:40 130 Minute Instructional Block

(10 min - Announcements, 40 min each for period 1, 2 and 3)

10:40-11:20

40 Minute Nutrition Break (20 min in, 20 min out)

11:20-12:40 80 Minute Instructional Block

(40 min each - periods 4, 5)

12:40-1:20 40 Minute Nutrition Break (20 min in, 20 min out)

1:20-2:50 90 Minute Instructional Block

(40 min each for period 6, 7, 10 min - end of day announcements)



Lyme Disease - Fight the Bite!!

Ticks, mosquitos and rabid animals have no boundaries and can be a risk to you and your family when walking to and from school or work, waiting at the bus stop, family trips, and while playing in the yard at home or at the park. Protect yourself and your family from West Nile Virus: Reduce standing water, as it's where mosquitoes breed. Cover up, wear long sleeved shirts, long pants, hats, socks and shoes Repair any damaged window screens. Use insect repellants containing DEET or Icardin (follow

manufacturer's instructions). Reduce the risk of Lyme disease: Wear light coloured clothing to help spot ticks Use insect repellants containing DEET or Icardin (follow manufacturer's instructions). Check yourself, your children and pets for ticks after being outdoors. Cut your grass and dispose of leaf litter where ticks can live. Presently, all of these diseases exist in Niagara.
