Blessing at Lakeshore Catholic on Thursday October 29 at 7:00. Our choir will be performing 2 songs. All parents are encouraged to attend.

-P.M. inquired about alternative practice times for choir since some children don't like to miss recess. It was determined that recess is the only time Madame is available to direct.

- Downtown Dolce-A family at our school owns this local bakery/ice cream establishment and is offering to give us customer appreciation cards to give to all the families at our school. These cards will get processed with each transaction and 5% of the totals will be returned to St. John Bosco School. It was decided that this is a win-win situation so M.K. will go ahead with it.
- Mad Science will do their presentation on Feb 12. This is an optional program for parents that runs from March 22 to April 26.
- Halloween A note went home asking parents to send in snacks with nutritional value. The children will wear black and orange in the morning and change into their costumes at lunch. A parade throughout the SJB neighbourhood will commence at 1PM. Again, parents and friends are encouraged to attend.
- Vendor Fair Sat November 21 from 10 to 3. Update from Shawna.
 We have 26 confirmed (paid) vendors plus more with verbal confirmations
 MK to send an electronic copy of the flyer to all council members for them to

forward to interested vendors and attendees.

-MK will also assist Shawna in sending out a mass email to vendors with further pertinent information

-Shawna is still looking for a Party Light & Pampered Chef Vendor -the grade 8's will be selling Spirit Wear, Popcorn & Ice Cream at the sale and **will make signs to advertise** the sale (Shawna will bring balloons to capture attention from the traffic on Main St.. -Let's Make a Deal Table will offer items donated by the vendors available for negotiable bids

-Goodie Bags (discounts, samples, etc.) will be offered to the 1st 100 people through the door

-Gym will be closed Friday afternoon to set up, volunteers are coming from 3:30 to 5:30 to assist.

Poinsettia Fundraiser –two different notes to go home to families, one for the grade 8 students to show how much money per poinsettia sold will come off their trip to Camp Mediva and one for ELKP-Grade 7.

-this year poinsettia buyers will receive tickets brought home by their children (or ticket seller) and can go to The Mill to select their own poinsettia thus avoiding the transportation and organization of the flowers at the school. -Poinsettia sales begin on Monday, November 2nd.

Remembrance Day – SJB Grade 7 & 8's will attend a Remembrance Day service at H.H. Knoll Park. The ELKP to Grade 6's will attend a ceremony at the flagpole in front of the school at 11:00 AM

-The entire school will attend mass at SJB Church in the afternoon.

December 16 the school will be at the YMCA all morning and then in the evening we will celebrate as a school community with an Advent Family Mass at 6:00 pm at St. John Bosco Church. MK will approach Father Peter to inquire about the possibility of him drawing a ticket for our Christmas Raffle after Mass has ended.

- During Advent we will be having weekly liturgies every Monday at 9:30 in the gym. Mrs. Zamora will include students in dramatic activity as part of the celebrations.
- Santa visits the school on Friday Dec 18 all morning or until he sees all the kids.
- MK announced that Smart TV's have been ordered and should be here before Christmas. One will be mounted to the wall in the portable for the grade 7's & 8's to share and the other is portable to be shared among classrooms.

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J.S. announced the Friends of SJB would like to do their fundraising raffle this year again. It was decided that the raffle tickets should be available to sell at our Vendor Sale on Nov. 21st. Julie will apply to the city for a Raffle License ASAP in order to get the tickets on time. MK will talk to Monique Marion about the printing of the tickets.
 -Heather formed a group of volunteers to cut and assemble the tickets on Tuesday Nov. 17th at 1:30 pm. Volunteers: Shawna, Patricia and Marissa

-2000 tickets will be printed \$2 per ticket or 3 for \$5, tickets will be 10 to a book plus one for the \$25 student prize (that is not numbered as part of our lottery license). Prizes will be \$500, \$250, and \$100 as well as the \$25 student prize.

Patricia is going to look into whether we could get a gently used toy drive going at the school to donate to Port Cares. She will inquire with them to see if there's a need. She thought it would be a way to teach the kids about giving back to the less fortunate. SJB does encourage and advocate for this through the Backpacks for Hope programme which is going on now at the school.
