- 3. Zones of Regulation Please see the school newsletter for articles on "Zones of Regulation". "Zones" is a self-regulation program used in all K-3 classes and in the school yard. The Learning Strategies Social Skills Class at MC also uses this metric for guiding student with self regulation. There will be a parent meeting held at St. Charles Catholic Elementary on April 27th at 6:00. Grade Eight students from MC will be here to help supervise St.Charles students while parents are in the information session. Zones of regulation practices, procedures and language will be carried forward next school year with the Grade four and five students at MC.
- 4. Knights of Columbus: will be donating a pizza snack to all students K-8 at both schools as a thank you for the community partnerships. Heather offered to approach her husband's employer to see if they could donate Yogurt drinks. She felt there was a possibility of getting ~250 drinks. Jenn Hamm offered to purchase Juice boxes for the remaining students. CSC members agreed that the Yogurt drinks will go to K-3 students and the drink boxes will be bought for our 4-8 students. Mrs. Walsh and Mr. Trainor agreed to share the expense of the juice. (update since our meeting Heather was able to obtain enough yogurt drinks for all K-3 students, Jenn will ensure the juice boxes are purchased for our 408 students).
- 5. Poinsettia orders: Another Success! \$484.30 profit for MC and \$1170.70 for St. Charles.
- 6. Big Box Fundraiser (St. Charles)- Huge Success total raised is \$6499.00. CSC members discussed how well the fundraiser worked and the terrific community support we had for it. After the discussion an agreement was made that while this was very successful we should wait another year or so before using it again so our families can us the cards they have purchased.
