- Awaiting for the installation of new basketball nets in the intermediate area

Purchases:

- Purchased 45 Chromebooks in June 2020 during Covid shutdown
- Will be purchasing more tech, (laptops, chromebooks, Epson Camera aka 'Elmos' and ceiling mounted short wave will be putting in a tech order for 4 labtops, 1 Epson mounted for classroom, 2 Document Cameras (Elmo), Chromebooks)
- Snack Program will resumes October, 2020 (Grab & Go)
- Curriculum Connection/Mental Health & Well Being Support:
- Supports/Programs in Place for Restorative Practice
- Mental Health Referrals: Board Social Worker or Pathstone Mental Health Social Worker
- Mentorship Program Grade 5 students partner with Child and Youth Care Worker (CYW) and Niagara College CYW student to support collaborative play during recess, Collaborative Problem Solving and Zones of Self-Regulation is already underway

- Continue lessons on flexible thinking, perspective taking and mindfulness by classroom teacher, CYW, Behaviour Resource Teacher, Education Resource Teacher and Principal
- Restorative Circles; Reparative Work with Peers supported by Classroom Teacher, ERT, Principal, and CYW and Mental Health Lead
- Collaboration with paraprofessionals (Board Social Worker/Board Mental Health Lead, Occupational Therapist)
