E. Principal Report –

- 2. **COVID Protocols:** restrictions have eased. No more co-horting of students. Thank you to all parents for being diligent with the isolation and monitoring protocols.
- 3. Hot Lunch/Pizza/Snack Sales: Swiss Chalet, Subway and Pizza continue to be well receive. Snack sales also well received (M,W,F). Thank you to Mrs. Psiloyenis for organizing and running all of our food days.
- 4. **Skating:** Jordan Arena April 6 and April 8. Any parents who have any skates and helmets. Mrs. Marshall will reach out to other hockey moms and collect more used skates and helmets. Thank you Mrs. Marshall! Thank you to all the parent supervisors for attending (Mrs. Belanger, Mrs. Marshall and Mrs. Carter's mom to name a few).
- 5. **40 Cans for Lent Food Drive- KOC/CCWN:** Mrs. Lamers explained the 40 Cans for Lent Food Drive for CCWN. Led by Gr. 7/8 students in Ms. Smith's class. Thank you to all the families who have donated canned goods for those in need.

Thank you to all the families who ordered perogies on April 6 and 13. Students may wear blue and yellow tops on Ukraine food days. Classrooms have been creating Ukrainian flags, sunflower and egg art as well.
