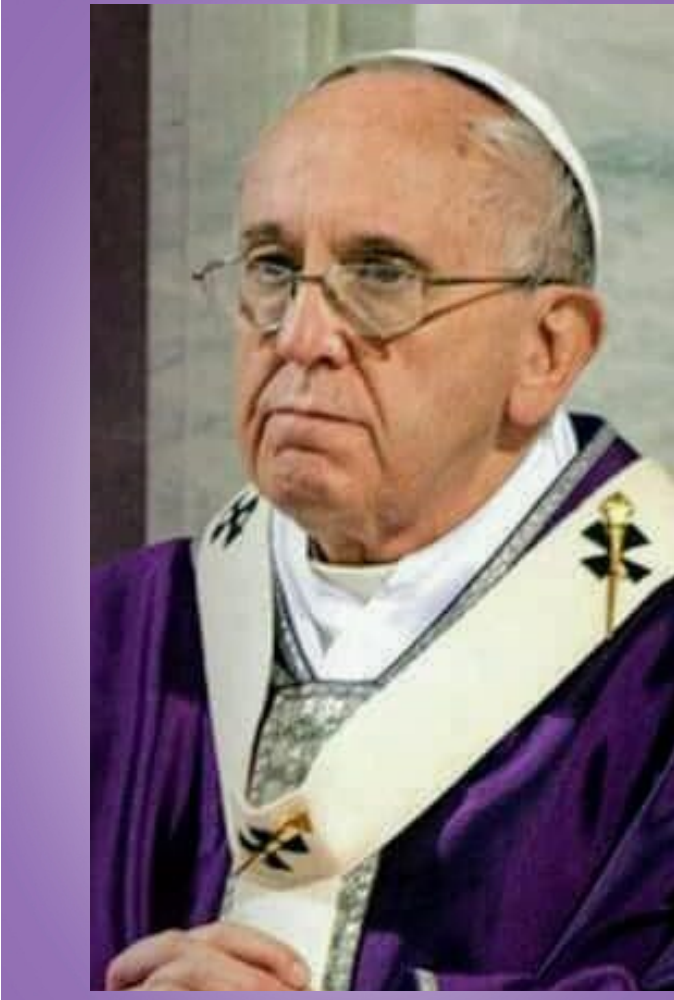

CATHOLIC SCHOOL COUNCIL

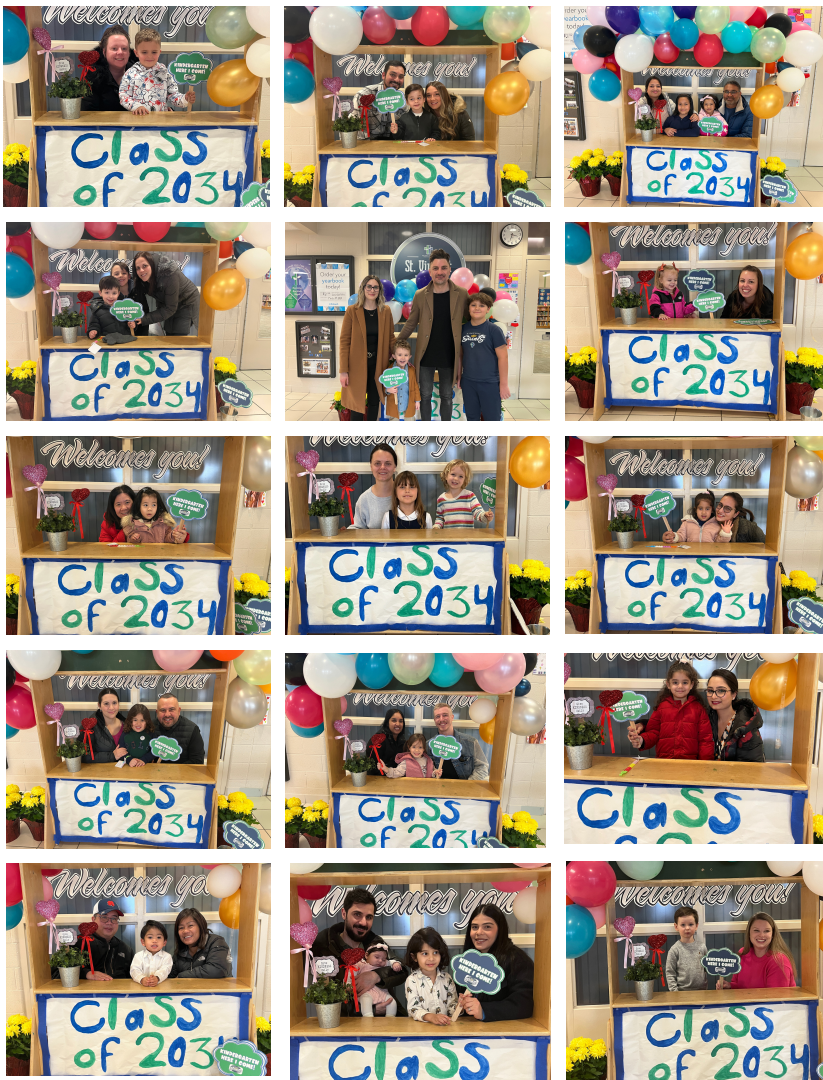

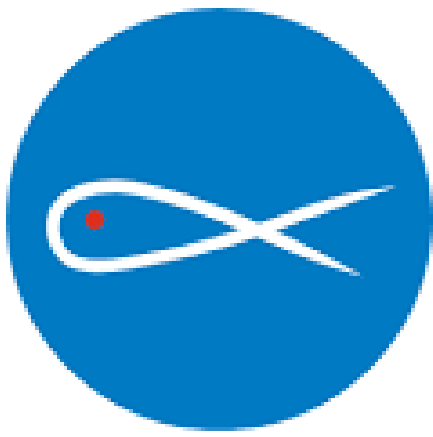
