SPRING WEATHER


With wet spring weather now in full swing, parents are reminded that students need to bring indoor shoes to school for health and safety reasons. Additionally, it is a good idea to bring a change of clothes, especially pants and socks, that students can change into if they get wet. We keep the students off of the field when it is excessively wet and muddy but at times students still manage to find it. Please remind your children to dress appropriately for the changing temperatures and label all of your child(ren)'s clothes.

CONCUSSION PROTOCOL

The Niagara Catholic District School Board recognizes concussions as a serious injury which requires appropriate follow-up measures to reduce the risk of potential additional injury. Concussion awareness, prevention, identification and management are a priority for the Board. The implementation of the Board's Concussion Administrative Operational Procedures is another important step in creating healthier schools in the Niagara Catholic District School Board

If staff, in communication with the school principal, suspects head trauma or a concussion might be possible based on signs and symptoms reported by the student, they are required to complete the appropriate documentation, call home and send home a copy of the documentation.

Medical doctors and nurse practitioners are the only healthcare professionals in Canada with licensed training and expertise to diagnose a concussion; therefore, all students with suspected concussions should undergo evaluation by one of these professionals.



ABSENT/LATE STUDENTS

The Safe arrival program is aimed at verifying the location and safety of each child in our school. Parents are asked to report their child's absences or lates before the start of school. The system will call you repeatedly if your child is not present in school once the bell rings.

Absences and lates can be quickly and conveniently reported in one of three ways:

1. Through the School Messenger App available through the Android or iOS app store.

2. By calling the automated telephone system at 1-844- 287-6287 through which absences can be reported.
