Advent Food and Toy Drive: Throughout the weeks of December 2rd - 13th, 2019, our St. Mark Intermediate and Junior Student councils are organizing the collection of toys and food to share with those in need this Advent/Christmas season.

Science Fair: The St. Mark Catholic School Science Fair will take place on Wednesday, February 5th, 2019.
