B. PRESENTATIONS

St. Mark Student Council report – Naia Crowley and Ava Seca presented the information and highlighted upcoming events in October: Food Drive and Dance-A-Thon

C. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT - Mr. Ward presented the following report:

N.C.D.S.B.: We are entering into the third year of the three year theological theme of "One Family in Christ: Know, Love, *Serve* Him." To be "One Family in Christ" is to embrace the diversity in our schools – to care for and support those who are struggling while upholding and encouraging others in their success.

Thanksgiving Food Drive: Our Saint Mark Student Council will be organizing the collection of food for our Thanksgiving Food Drive, throughout October 2nd - 5th, 2017.

Family Advent Mass: On Saturday, December 9th, at 5 p.m. the St. Mark Community will be hosting a Family Advent Mass. We see this as a way of helping to strengthen the Triad of Home - School – Church. All are welcome!

Student Achievement

E.Q.A.O.: We received and have analyzed the E.Q.A.O. summary data. The St. Mark results are as follows: Grade Three Reading 70%; Writing 70%; and Mathematics 68%; Grade Six Reading 83%; Writing 75%; and Mathematics 55%. We are awaiting the I.R.R. data that will further help to create the foci for our instruction in the 2017-18 school year.

Using Data to Drive Assessment: The staff and administration of St. Mark are in the process of completing our Annual School Improvement Plan that will guide our educational direction throughout this coming school year. The St. Mark staff will utilize the data collected from the Primary and Junior EQAO assessments, the Diagnostic data (OCA/DRA/Obs. Survey.), and classroom data to help drive their instruction to improve student achievement. There will be three main foci for St. Mark School for the 2017-18 academic year – Mathematics, Science, and Technology.

Technology in the Classroom: We are looking to augment the technological equipment that we currently have at Saint Mark to allow for the largest increase in student achievement. One Hundred and Fifty Chromebooks were purchased last year and another purchase will be made this year.

School Climate

Open House/B.B.Q.: On Thursday, September 14th, 2017, we welcomed families to the school for our Open house. Approximately 500 people came out to tour the school, their children's classrooms, and learn more about the educational program that the students at St. Mark will receive this year. In addition, the Knights of Columbus provided a B.B.Q. for all families. Thank you to all parents for your support of this event!

Terry Fox Walk: On Friday, September 22nd, we completed the annual Terry Fox Walk for Cancer Research. All classes participated in the walk as we raised approximately \$1000.00 for cancer research. Thank you for your continued support!

Student Council: On Friday, September 22^{nd} at St. Mark, we elected an Intermediate Student Council to enhance and encourage student voice. Our first meeting of the Intermediate Student Council will take place on Monday, October 2^{nd} , from 3:00-4:00 p.m. A Junior Council will be selected next week and will be mentored by the Intermediate Council.

Hallowe'en Dance-a-thon: The Student Council will be organizing a Hallowe'en Dance-a-thon for the students of St. Mark. This activity will serve to increase school spirit, raise funds for Technology equipment and St. Helen Church, and allow this year's Student Council to take on a leadership role within the school. This will be an out of dress code day for all students – as they are invited to wear either a school appropriate costume or orange and black clothing in the spirit of the day.
