#### D. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 1. Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee Report
  - Set new year-3 sub committees open to all Faith Formation
  - Project Prom collecting gently used dresses and suits ie: Gr 2 Communion outfits, grade 8 & 12 grad dresses and suits. Volunteers from another community will be running the project prom to protect anonymity of the families in need.
- 2. Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) Report
- 3. Catholic School Council Financial Report:
  - The Wine Fundraiser has been purchased by 8 families up to date, we are only at \$1,140 sold.
  - The Dance-A-Thon raised a total of \$5,596.00, less expenses of \$572.93 (Chromebook, AirPods and Popcorn) = \$5,023.07 for our total fundraiser.
  - Purchasing new jerseys reversible basketball shirts and extra t-shirts for events such as chess, science fairs, etc.

#### 4. Catholicity

- We had a school mass here on the 12th
- Our grade 8 parents/guardians had their Confirmation information night at the church. Confirmation is set for Saturday, March 3, 2024.
- Our grade 8s had their Journey Retreat & Pilgrimage on Friday, October 27<sup>th</sup>.
- And we had our 1<sup>st</sup> Communion mass here at the school for our grade 2 students on November 7<sup>th</sup>.

#### 5. Student Achievement

- Math & Literacy continues to be a focus of PD for staff.
- Today we had our Lit and Math leads here along with Chaplains for training.
- The grade 7 & 8 classes have extra sessions focusing on de-streaming literacy
- EQAO results are in. At or above standards **Grade 3**: reading 81.3% (72.6%), writing 56% (65.5%), Math 62.5% (59.7%) **Grade 6**: reading 100% (83.7), writing 96.6% (83.6%), math 48.35 (49.5%)

## 6. School Climate

- Student Council is doing our food drive now. Toy drive in December. Lead Out Conference is this Wednesday.
- We had our Intermediate soccer tournaments in October as well as Cross Country. Cross country went well with 6 students making it to the board meet where we had a second and third place finish.
- Progress reports are due to be released tomorrow afternoon.
- Grade 7s had their vaccinations.
- Parent-teacher interviews are set for the 23<sup>rd</sup> of November.
