D. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 1) Catholic School Council Fundraising Financial Report Mr. Forte shared the Catholic School Council Financial Reports as of 25/04/2023.
- 2) Interactive Classroom TVs The school has purchased two 65 inch interactive TVs for Room 108 (currently occupied by our Grade 4 class) and Room 119 (currently occupied by our Grade 1/2 French Immersion class).
- 3) Additional Chromebooks The school has placed an order for the purchase of 30 additional Chromebooks.
- 4) **King Street Sidewalk** The Town of Lincoln and the Board's Facilities Services Department continue to work together to finalize construction of the sidewalk along King Street and connect it to the existing walkway on school property. The school will communicate with families once confirmation is received by the Town of Lincoln and Facilities Services that the sidewalk is fully functional and safe for use.
- 5) **Lenten & Easter Food Drive** Our Lenten & Easter Food Drive for the *Grimsby Benevolent Fund* was a tremendous success. The school gathered over 1,000 lbs of non-perishable items!
- 6) EQAO Digitalized Assessments All students in Grades 3 and 6 who are accessing the Ontario Curriculum are expected to participate in the assessments. Assessments will take place digitally, using school devices from May 23 26 (Grade 3 students) and May 29 June 1 (Grade 6 students).
- 7) Catholic Education & Mental Health Week Niagara Catholic schools will be participating in Catholic Education Week with the theme of "We are Many, We are One", in conjunction with Mental Health Week, from Monday, May 1, 2022 to Friday, May 5. Further details regarding Catholic Education & Mental Health Week activities are outlined in the April 24 letter to families.
- 8) Anti-Black Racism Parent Presentation As a follow-up to the student workshops that took place in February, the school has booked a parent presentation to take place here at the school on *Thursday, May 25* from *6:00 pm 7:30 pm*.
- 9) **Little Jammerz Guitar Program (Grades 1-6)** Students were provided with information forms on April 18 to bring home for parents to review. Parents are asked to complete their child's registration if interested in participating in the program.
- 10) **Knights of Columbus Lunch BBQ** The Knights of Columbus will be running a BBQ for students here at the school on Friday, June 2. Students can purchase a hotdog or hamburger with a bag for chips for \$5.00. Orders are to be submitted via 'SchoolCash' Online. All money raised will be put toward local charitable causes through the Knights of Columbus. Details will be shared with families in the coming weeks.
- 11) Meet the Staff Open House & Knights of Columbus BBQ This is tentatively scheduled to take place on Thursday, September 14 from 4:00 pm 7:00 pm. The school is looking for parent volunteers from the Catholic School Council to run an exchange for gently used elementary standardized dress code items during the event.
- 12) **Term 2 Report Cards** Term 2 Ontario Provincial Report Cards will be made available in the <u>Niagara Catholic Parent Portal</u> the week of June 26. This reporting period reflects learning that has occurred since the commencement of Term 2 on February 1, 2023.

- 13) **2023-2024 Classroom Placements** Due to ongoing changes in teaching staff throughout the Board, the name of your child's classroom teacher for the 2023-2024 school year will appear in the <u>Niagara Catholic Parent Portal</u> in late August / early September.
- 14) **School Summer Garden Maintenance -** Catholic School Council Members and anyone wishing to assist with garden maintenance over the summer months are asked to contact Mrs. Binfield.

- 1) **Niagara Catholic Parent Involvement Committee (NCPIC) 2023-2024** Information regarding nominations and the application process will be included in our May newsletter.
- 2) Niagara Catholic Parent Engagement Night A notification was sent to all families on March 22 inviting parents to attend and participate in a faith formation and parent engagement night with Father Tony Ricard. The event will take place at Denis Morris Catholic Secondary School on Wednesday, May 3. Details, including registration information, are outlined in the notification.
- 3) Reading in the Early Years Parent Information Session A notification was sent to all families of children in Kindergarten to Grade 2 on April 19 inviting them to participate in the virtual session. The session takes place on Tuesday, May 2 from 6:00 pm 7:30 pm. Families of students registered to begin in Kindergarten in September were also notified via email.

4) Practice Fire & Lockdown Drills:

- ✓ **Fire drills** Fire drills are to be conducted at a minimum of <u>six</u> times throughout the duration of the school year (three per term), all at various times of the day. St. John has completed *three* of its *six* required fire drills this year.
- ✓ **Lockdown drills** Lockdown drills are to be conducted at a minimum of <u>two</u> times throughout the duration of the school year (two per term). St. John has completed <u>both</u> of its *two* required lockdown drills this year.
- 5) **Student Absences & Late Arrivals** It is essential that all student absences and late arrivals are called into the Safe Arrival Program by <u>8:30 am</u> via phone (1-844-287-6287), website or app.
- 6) **'SchoolMessenger'** The school will continue to use the 'SchoolMessenger' platform to update the parent community with essential information pertaining to the school.
- 7) **'SchoolCash' Online** The use of this platform to make payments for school related expenses is highly encouraged. Further information is on the St. John Google Website.
