- 2. Lexia is another reading support we have here. Our numbers with this program is also showing remarkable gains. With our success and commitment to using this program, we have been given more than our allotted amount of licenses.
- 3. Science of Reading is now in full swing in our K-2 classes. Teachers have been receiving ongoing training on this resource, and we have purchased 5 complete kits for our staff.
- 4. Math-Up continues to be the driving resource for our Numeracy program.
