  - i) Start of School Covid-19 Health and Safety Protocols
    - Our protocols remain very similar to what they were last year. Please continue to contact Mr. Venzon if you have any questions.
  - ii) Masses / Sacraments -
    - Confirmation Friday, December 3, 2021
    - First Reconciliation and Holy Communion TBD
    - We will also have a Thanksgiving mass outside with all classes and Fr. Wesley on October 6th. Rain dates of Oct 7 and 8th.
  - i) Fundraising for 2021-22
    - -Discussion of the fundraiser last year with the lottery calendar in May. Discussed doing another lottery calendar in Feb. of 2022. Also will be doing the Dance-a-thon fundraiser on Halloween (Oct 29th) of this year, which makes some money for the kids as well.
  - iii) Niagara Nutrition Program Grab and go... Same setup as last year
  - iv) School Improvement MathUp School, MathUp Classroom, Dreambox, Lexia Reading
    - Question about IXL Math. Mr. Venzon explained this is not a Board purchased program, and although it is used for practice math at home with kids, we are behind the Dream box program in Primary for our students. It is an excellent program that is based on research that works to enhance gaps for kids by making math fun and engaging.

MathUP Classroom is a comprehensive, online, K–8 instructional solution that helps build teachers' knowledge and understanding of mathematics so that they can better help their students.

With a focus on building consistency from grade to grade and increasing each teacher's confidence in making instructional decisions, MathUP Classroom also addresses all expectations in the Ontario mathematics curriculum.

v) Primary Division Reorganization - effective tomorrow, Sept 29, addition of another classroom. Our class sizes in Primary have dropped from 22 and 24, to 14, 16, 16. We are very fortunate to have received an extra teacher and are welcoming Mrs. Gillespie back to grade 1. We are also welcoming Ms. De Luca as our new Primary Team Member and Kindergarten Prep teacher.

- Question about whether or not Ms. De Luca works at another school.
   Mr. Venzon explained that she does. Question as to which school.
   Mr. Venzon did not provide the name of the other school. If relevant information needed to be provided regarding Covid-19 exposure from a teacher who works at another school, we would comply with all Public Health requests and guidelines.
