Overview of what the company offers:

- -portrait quality
- 5 light set up
- proofs 2 pictures that generate 8 different poses/backgounds. Parents can go online and choose own backgrounds as well, can mix and match poses within the package, they are the only company that offers that feature.
 - Customer Service- has a parent hotline, school is in touch with Karen direct.
- -Pricing and comparisons: \$49 (7.5 sheets of pictures) Pegasus-\$49.00 but one sheet of pictures less. Bottom package-\$22 Pegasus \$17.00 but Lifetouch has 1 sheet more. CD only \$25, them \$29. Price per sheet \$11 Life touch \$16 Pegasus. Family plan offered as well-same as other companies, online ordering. Link can be put on the School Cash website to direct parents to their website. Pictures to protect cards- connected to Canada Centre for Child Protection- call 800 # and picture will be released to proper authorities.
 - retouching \$7, free class pictures, credit card payment,
- -school rewards program- multi-year agreement, street signs (come in a set of 10) can have whatever you want on them, anti-bullying program- choose what they want to say, large one in front entry, and small in every class. Stand-alone banners or regular banners- can be customized with what is on them. Montage posters- with all the kids on it. Sibling photography can be offered as well, usually in the spring when Grad photography is done. Beginning of year, cameras are calibrated for headshots only.

School makes \$1.00 per picture- everyone is encouraged to get spring photo done as a small fundraiser.
