 - As of April 30, 2019, the bingo account has a balance of \$5, 576.21

 - The classroom staff has been reduced from 17 classroom teachers to 15 classroom teachers below grade five the numbers for each grade are below 30, and so the enrollment is likely to continue to decrease over the coming years as larger classes graduate and smaller classes begin school
