
Each participating school has been assigned one type of food to donate. St. Vincent de Paul School has been asked to bring in **apple sauce (family size and snack packs)**.

We thank you in advance for supporting this amazing cause.



Vision Health Month

Visual health is an important part of a child's overall health and well-being. Proper vision is important for a child's movement and coordination, independence, play and learning. If left untreated, vision problems may become serious and prevent a child from reaching their full potential.



A yearly eye exam is **FREE** – the Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) covers the cost of an eye exam every 12 months for children up to the age of 19 with a valid OHIP card. Find an eye doctor near you.

Also, contact an eye doctor if you see **ANY** of these signs:

 Squinting or holding objects close to the eyes 	One eye that turns out or in
Blinking often	 Rubbing, tearing, itchy or burning eyes
 Turning or tilting the head to the side often 	Reporting blurry or double vision
Covering or closing one eye	Reporting headaches, nausea or eye strain

NEW Quit Vaping Program for Youth

The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) is excited to launch **Youth-Vaping**, **Substance use, and Technology (VAST)**. Youth-VAST is a program for youth in Ontario who are using vaping, substances, or feel like technology is taking up too much

of their time. This program brings together existing and new resources across CAMH to deliver virtual services directly to youth and their family.
