






June Reflection

Weekly Update June 2 - 6, 2025

Dear St. Anthony Families,

You wouldn't know it from the weather, but come this Sunday, June has arrived. Where has this year gone? There are only 19 school

days remaining, and a great deal taking place in that time. Please check those email reminders so you don't miss out on the fun.

The deadline to send in items for our Spring Raffle Baskets was today, however if you forgot to send in that item, you set aside to send in, you can still do so on Monday. We will be wrapping the baskets this week and getting ready for ticket sales on Monday June 9th. Our Draws will take place on Friday June 13th, just in time for Father's Day. Like last year, ticket sheets will be \$10/sheet and each sheet has 25 tickets that can be spread out however you feel. Thank you to everyone who has contributed. (see poster below)

On Monday, all students will receive a glass of Lemonade as part of our FACS-Mountainview Homes fundraiser. Donations can be made by going to the website provided on the poster below or by clicking here. Students may also bring in donations and they will be collected by the classroom teacher and sent to the office. Our goal is to raise \$2/student and staff. Any amount will be accepted. Thank you in advance.

On Monday, June 2, 2025 we will be hosting our Kindergarten Open House for those students starting in Kindergarten this September. If you have registered with us or are planning on registering your child please come out and join us. We will review the Kindergarten program, provide a tour of the school and finish up with a First Ride program for the students and parents where they will get to ride a school bus. If you are still waiting to register your child(ren), please go to niagaracatholic.ca and begin the registration process. Knowing what our numbers are for the new year will help us to staff the school appropriately and avoid overcrowded classes. If you know anyone with a child born in 2021, please pass this along and bring them with you. Registration forms will be available that evening.

On Tuesday, June 3, 2025, we will have a group from the organization "NED" perform for our students. The group focuses on resiliency and perseverance. The presentation is filled with storytelling, humour, and fun yo-yo tricks. The presentation is free to our school as NED follows a pay-it-forward model. This is accomplished through the sale of yo-yos and accessories. A copy of the items being sold was sent home earlier this week and a paper copy will be sent home with all students. If you feel like purchasing a yo-yo, we will have them available for sale following the presentation on June 3rd up until June 10th. All proceeds go to help NED continue to pay it forward to another school. There is a link on the form if you want to learn more about NED.

On Monday, June 2, 2025 students who qualified for our Denis Morris Family of Schools Track and Field Meet will represent us at the Niagara Olympic Park. Consent forms and a schedule were sent home with all those who qualified. Please ensure those forms are returned.

We want to remind students that proper footwear must be worn when participating in any physical activity. Crocs, sandals, Ugg slippers or flip flops are not suitable for various field trips and especially during Physical Education classes. Unfortunately, if a student is not wearing the proper footwear for the activity, they will not be permitted to participate. This goes for recess as well. There have been too many injuries due to improper footwear. Also, students should be wearing sturdy, supportive shoes at school. Open-toed sandals and flip-flops are not safe for school because of the potential hazards when there are many people in a certain area.

With some families leaving for vacation early, we continue to urge you to put your child's absence in the SafeArrival system. It can be done from your phone from anywhere you have Wi-Fi access. Also, if you get a call from the school, please answer and just respond accordingly. This helps a great deal with our daily attendance procedures. Also, it helps us to know your child is safe.

The last of our year-end field trips have been posted as well as all of our specialty lunch days. Please make sure you have purchased what you wish to purchase before the item closes. Closure dates are firm as we must confirm our numbers with vendors by a certain date. If you want to make the purchase but cannot by the deadline, please call your child's teacher and reserve your spot and we will make arrangements for payment at a later time.

We have made multiple announcements to have students come and look at our Lost and Found in order to claim items that belong to them. We urge you to please remind your children to go and look for an item that you know is missing. After Wednesday, we will be bagging up all the items, washing what is useable here at school and bringing the remainder of the items to Goodwill. We have coats, sweaters, shoes, boots and more.

With June starting this Sunday, all schools and sites of the Niagara Catholic District School board will be flying the Progressive Pride Flag. By flying the Progress Pride flag at our schools and sites, Niagara Catholic is creating a visible symbol of acceptance and safety for our students who identify as part of the LGBTQ2S+ community, and for their families and allies. Knowing that their school is a safe and accepting place contributes to the mental health and wellbeing of our students.

Lastly, we want to say thank you and good luck to Mrs. Gambale. Mrs. Gambale will be leaving St. Anthony at the end of the school year. She will be taking her many talents to Canadian Martyrs in September 2025. She will be dearly missed by staff, students and the entire St. Anthony community. Safe Arrival-School Messenger
