



# The New Evangelization





- Ardent and courageous proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- Authentic teaching of the doctrine of the Church
- Adapted to the needs of the times
- Repromotes enculturation of the faith

- Responsibility of all Baptized
- Promotes laws and institutions in harmony with Christ's teachings
- Evangelizes not only individual, but cultures and societies
- Focus on Ecumenical and Inter-religious dialogue

### The 8 Elements of the New Evangelization



#### **OPTION A:** THINK / PAIR / SHARE




#### **OPTION B:** THINK / PAIR / SHARE
